Dear Resident,

Windy Arbor Road / Lickers Lane – Junction Improvement Scheme

The Council has identified that at peak times the junction of Windy Arbor Road and Lickers Lane is over capacity and this leads to excessive queues forming. In addition, further developments within Whiston and Halsnead Park areas are planned to start in the near future which are expected to bring increased traffic flows at this junction.

To better control traffic movements the Council has secured funding to improve the capacity of the junction. The proposed scheme will involve the construction of a Traffic Signal Controlled Junction, which will also include some road widening. An additional benefit of the scheme will be the improved pedestrian crossing facilities at the junction.

For your information I enclose a General Arrangement Plan of the proposed Traffic Signal Junction Scheme. I would highlight that the plan may not show the final arrangement as the layout and features may change during construction. A date to commence construction work has not been finalised yet. However, it is anticipated to commence on site in Summer 2021 and be completed in Autumn 2021.

Some delays and disruption are expected during construction, as temporary traffic signals will be required to facilitate the works. The Contractors involved will try to keep these delays to a minimum. Access to residential properties will be maintained at all times, except where it is necessary to complete the works. The majority of the works will be undertaken during week days, although some works may need to be programmed for the weekend or evenings.
